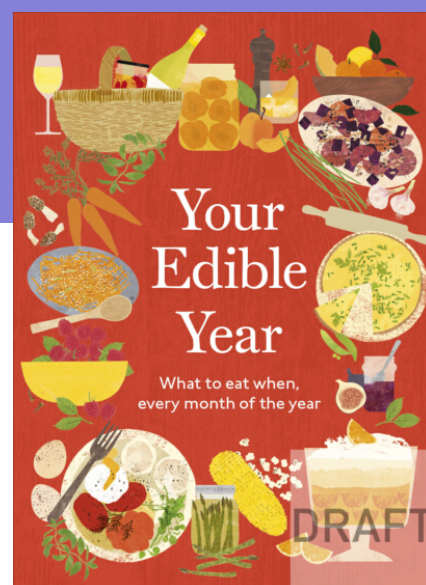

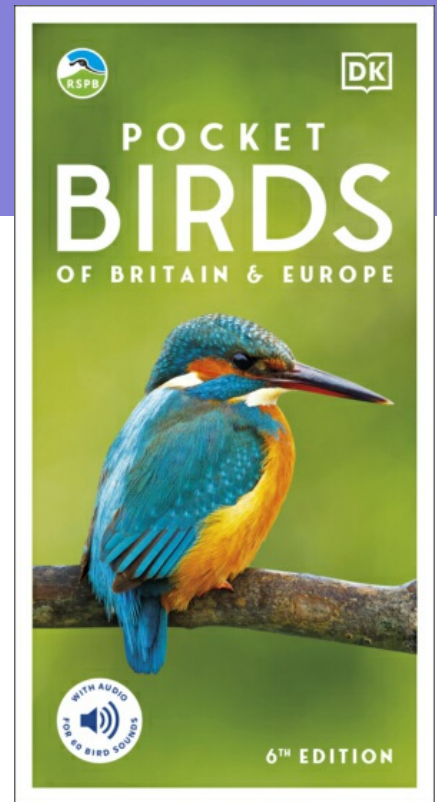

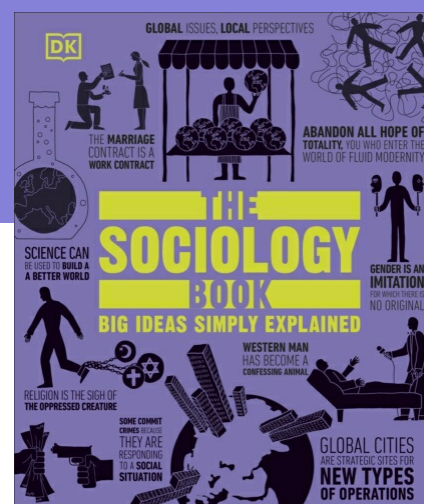

A firsthand account of what it's like to spend a year living and working in Antarctica through the eternal winter
